

Dear Patient,

We are writing today with an important reminder about Mount Sinai's participation with your insurance carrier.

As of Saturday, March 1, Mount Sinai Health System will no longer be in Humana's Medicare Advantage network. This means that Humana will no longer cover your care with us at in-network rates. We know how important it is for you to have in-network access to the Mount Sinai physicians and services you trust, and that is why we want to remind you that the Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment Period is still underway.

Through Monday, March 31, you have the opportunity to make a one-time change to your Medicare coverage. Once you make this change, your new coverage will begin on the first day of the following month. That means if you choose a new Medicare Advantage plan by March 31, you will regain your in-network access to Mount Sinai physicians and services on April 1.

Here's what you need to know:

- As you evaluate the options available to you, please keep in mind that in addition to certain Medicare Advantage plans, Mount Sinai also participates with Original (traditional) Medicare and all Medicare supplement plans.

- If you wish to continue seeing your Mount Sinai care team but do not want to switch plans at this time, you have the option to:
 - Use out-of-network benefits if your current plan has those benefits
 - Self-pay at the out-of-network rate
